"OUI" vs "SI": Which One to Choose?

100 "Oui" Vs." Si": Which One to Choose?



THE RULE:

- If you are answering "yes" to an affirmative question in French, the translation for "yes" is "oui."
- If you are answering "yes" to a negative question in French, the translation for "yes" is "si."

EXAMPLES:

- Q: Vous comprenez ma question? (Do you understand my question?)
- A: Oui, je comprend votre question. (Yes, I understand your question.)
- Q: Vous ne comprenez pas ma question? (Don't you understand my question?)
- A: Si, je comprends votre question. (Yes, I understand your question.)
- Q: Tu aimes les pâtes ? (Do you like pasta?)
- A: Oui, j'aime les pâtes. (Yes, I like pasta.)
- O: Tu n'aimes pas les pâtes ? (Don't you like pasta?)
- A: <u>Si</u>, j'aime les pâtes. (<u>Yes</u>, I like pasta.)
