HOW TO TRANSLATE "FROM" + COUNTRY (FEMININE OR MASCULINE)

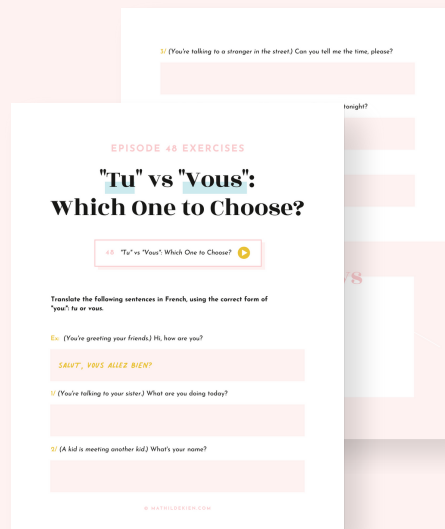
MASCULINE SINGULAR COUNTRY	FEMININE SINGULAR COUNTRY	STARTING WITH A VOWEL COUNTRY	PLURAL COUNTRY
du	de	d'	des

EXAMPLES

- ✓ Je viens du Canada. (I come from Canada.)
- ✓ Je viens de France. (I come from France.)
- ✓ Je viens d'Algérie. (I come from Algeria.) / Je viens d'Iran. (I come from Iran.)
- ✓ Je viens des États-Unis. (I come from the United States.)

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
