(FEMININE OR MASCULINE)

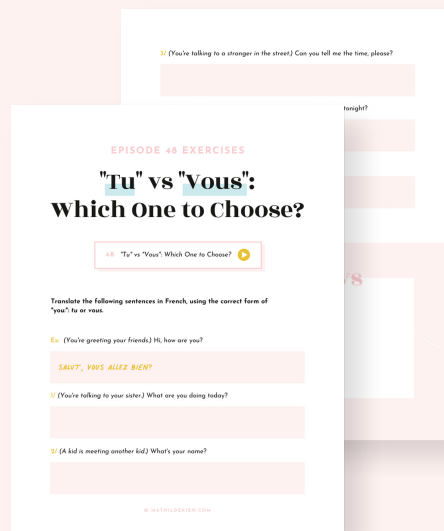
MASCULINE SINGULAR COUNTRY	FEMININE SINGULAR COUNTRY	STARTING WITH A VOWEL COUNTRY	PLURAL COUNTRY
au	en	en	aux

EXAMPLES

- ✓ J'habite au Canada. (I live in Canada.) / Je vais au Canada. (I go to Canada.)
- ✓ J'habite en France. (I live in France.) / Je vais en France. (I go to France.)
- ✓ J'habite en Algérie. (I live in Algeria.) / Je vais en Iran. (I go to Iran.)
- ✓ J'habite aux États-Unis. (I live in the United States.)

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
