de / d' *	à	à

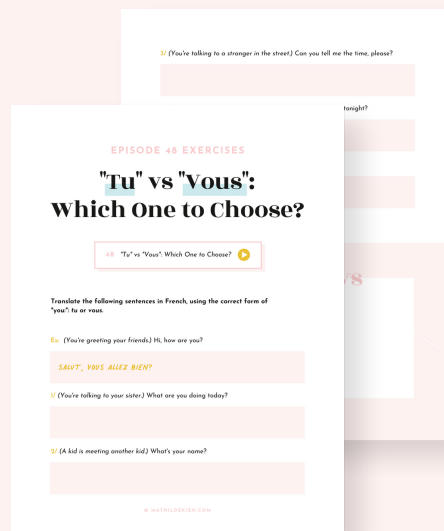
** (IF COUNTRY STARTS WITH A VOWEL)*

EXAMPLES

- ✓ Je viens de Paris. (I come from Paris.)
- ✓ Je viens d'Amsterdam. (I come from Amsterdam.)
- ✓ Je vais à Paris. (I'm going to Paris.)
- ✓ J'habite à Paris. (I live in Paris.)
