67 How to Say “There Is/There Are” in French



- **there is / there are = il y a**

EXAMPLES

- **Dans mon jardin, il y a un arbre.** (In my garden, there is a tree.)
- **Dans mon jardin, il y a des fleurs.** (In my garden, there are flowers.)
- **Il y a une pomme sur la table.** (There is an apple on the table.)
- **Il y a des fraises sur la table.** (There are strawberries on the table.)


- **there isn't / there aren't = il n'y a pas**

EXAMPLES

- **Dans mon jardin, il n'y a pas d'arbre.** (In my garden, there isn't any tree.)
- **Dans mon jardin, il n'y a pas de fleurs.** (In my garden, there aren't any flowers.)
- **Il n'y a pas de pomme sur la table.** (There isn't any apple on the table.)
- **Il n'y a pas de fraises sur la table.** (There aren't strawberries on the table.)
