67 How to Say “There Is/There Are” in French



- there is / there are = il y a

EXAMPLES

- Dans mon jardin, il y a un arbre. (In my garden, there is a tree.)
- Dans mon jardin, il y a des fleurs. (In my garden, there are flowers.)
- Il y a une pomme sur la table. (There is an apple on the table.)
- Il y a des fraises sur la table. (There are strawberries on the table.)

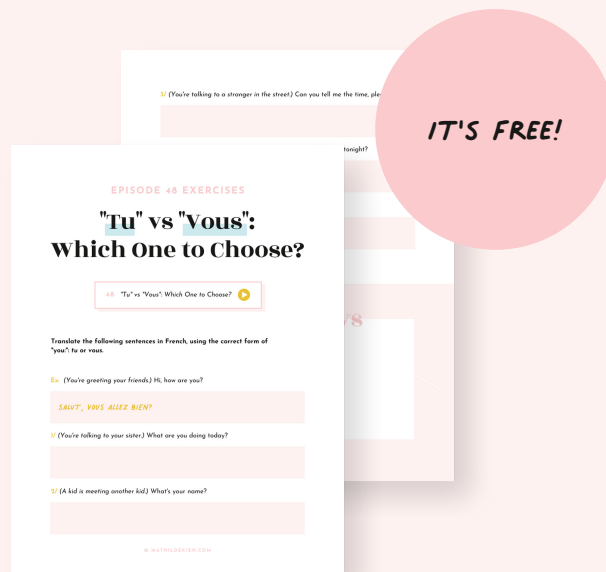
- there isn't / there aren't = il n'y a pas

EXAMPLES

- Dans mon jardin, il n'y a pas d'arbre. (In my garden, there isn't any tree.)
- Dans mon jardin, il n'y a pas de fleurs. (In my garden, there aren't any flowers.)
- Il n'y a pas de pomme sur la table. (There isn't any apple on the table.)
- Il n'y a pas de fraises sur la table. (There aren't strawberries on the table.)

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
