77 "Demander" Vs. "Poser Une Question"



- demander (to ask)
- poser une question (to ask a question)

### EXAMPLES

- Il demande de l'aide. (He's asking for help.)
- Je lui demande de ranger sa chambre. (I'm asking him/her to tidy up his/her room.)
- Il pose beaucoup de questions. (He asking many questions.)

Don't say: "Il demande beaucoup de questions." ❌

- Je lui pose une question difficile. (I'm asking him/her a difficult question.)

Don't say: "Je lui demande une question difficile." ❌
