

CHEAT SHEET

How to Conjugate French Verb "Devoir" (to Have To) [Present Tense]

CONJUGATION

- je **dois** (I have to)
- tu **dois** (you have to - singular informal)
- il **doit** (he has to)
- elle **doit** (she has to)
- on **doit** (we have to - informal)
- nous **devons** (we have to - formal)
- vous **devez** (you have to - plural or sing. formal)
- ils **doivent** (they have to - masculine)
- elles **doivent** (they have to - feminine)

PRONUNCIATION

Don't pronounce the final letters: 's', 't', 'ent'

 *Not always the case!*

EXAMPLES

- Je dois travailler. (I have to work.)
- Tu dois faire la vaisselle. (Tu dois faire la vaisselle.)
- Il doit étudier pour son examen. (He has to study for his exam.)
- Elle doit étudier pour son examen. (She has to study for her exam.)
- On doit partir bientôt. (We have to leave soon.)
- Nous devons manger plus sainement. (We have to eat healthier.)
- Vous devez aller chez le médecin. (You have to go to the doctor.)
- Ils doivent faire les courses. (They have to do the grocery shopping.)
- Elles doivent faire les courses. (They have to do the grocery shopping.)



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
