	MASCULINE SINGULAR	FEMININE SINGULAR	PLURAL
MY	mon livre	ma voiture / mon école*	mes parents
YOUR	ton livre	ta voiture / ton école*	tes parents
HIS/HER/ITS	son livre	sa voiture / son école*	ses parents
OUR	<u>notre</u> livre	<u>notre</u> voiture	<u>nos</u> parents
YOUR (PLURAL)	<u>votre</u> livre	<u>votre</u> voiture	<u>vos</u> parents
THEIR	<u>leur</u> livre	<u>leur</u> voiture	<u>leurs</u> parents

* before a feminine noun starting with a vowel
