MY	<u>mon</u> livre	<u>ma</u> voiture / <u>mon</u> école*	<u>mes</u> parents
YOUR	<u>ton</u> livre	<u>ta</u> voiture / <u>ton</u> école*	<u>tes</u> parents
HIS/HER/ITS	<u>son</u> livre	<u>sa</u> voiture / <u>son</u> école*	<u>ses</u> parents
OUR	notre	notre	nos
YOUR (PLURAL)	votre	votre	vos
THEIR	leur	leur	leurs
